**2020-2021 HUD ANNUAL ACTION PLAN (Draft) and the Notice of

 Is Now Available for Public Review and Comment**

REVISED/CORRECTED NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Federal regulations governing Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and other U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development programs require that a participating jurisdiction provide citizens with reasonable notice of and an opportunity to comment on the Annual Action Plan and Funding Recommendations that will direct the City's use of Community Development Block Grant funds. These funds provide programs that benefit low- to-moderate income persons in the City. The City of Miami Gardens will receive an allocation of \$1,098,576 from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program and 15% of the funds \$164,786 is set aside for public services to provide information and services to low income residents of the City of Miami Gardens. Listed below are the proposed goals and financial summary for each of the planned activities for the City.

- Housing Programs – \$219,715**
- Disaster Response - \$54,929**
- Economic Development Activity – \$109,858**
- CDBG Administration – \$219,715**
- Public Services – \$164,786**
- Improve & Expand Public**
